I. Call to order: Lewis called the meeting to order at 7:05pm.

III. Acceptance of Minutes: Upon *Motion* by Lewis, seconded by Kornacki then carried unanimously, the Minutes from the March 15, 2021 meeting were accepted as presented.

#### IV. Old Business

a) Chelbi Wade is moving Shell and Bee Studio to the former Pandemonium space. SoMA, South of Main Art Collective, was founded in an effort to form a creative collective where workshops, events and classes are run. Wade is closing the studio in May for renovations and plans to reopen June 11, 2021. Wade stated the ADA issue has not been resolved. Kornacki agreed to work with Selectman McDonald to investigate state grants for ADA compliance. Wade has met with Essex Economic Development Commission and wishes to connect Essex and Deep River art wise. Attached is additional information about the collective including mission, programs and class offerings.

b) Courtney Hendricson, of AdvanceCT discussed specific categories that will be included in the survey draft including demographics, Life in Deep River, town services, development, and infrastructure. Tony Bolduc suggested the survey include a question regarding recreational marijuana in Deep River. The Commission agreed. Lewis proposed a September 2021 release. Hendricson stated the survey will be powered by Survey Monkey. Hendricson agreed to attend the May 17, 2021 regular meeting with a draft of survey questions.

### V. New Business

- a) Kornacki provided an update from the recent Deep River Elementary School Board of Education budget meeting stating a required budget cut could impact a teaching position. There was discussion on whether EDC should get involved. Reyher suggested enrollment information be obtained for further discussion.
- b) Reyher stated Atwood Auto is interested in opening a carwash near the current site. It was suggested George attend the next regular meeting to discuss the business plan.
- VI. Adjournment: Upon *Motion* by Lewis, seconded by Sbrolla and carried unanimously, the meeting adjourned at 8:04pm. The next regularly scheduled meeting will be held on May 17, 2021 at 7pm at the Town Hall.

I appreciate all your help in finding resources to help the studio get ready for the opening. There are definitely a lot of moving parts but we are really excited to see what the studio will be able to offer Deep River and the surrounding area. Here is a little information regarding a few points we discussed tonight.

**SoMA:** SoMA, which stands for "South of Main Art Collective" was founded in an effort to form a creative collective where workshops, events, & classes are run. We are focused on connecting community and arts. Regularly scheduled art openings, and events where clients and community members can connect with artists and makers

The mission of SoMA is to foster connections among artists and the public that ignite the creative spirit. The studio provides opportunities for interactions in the arts. we bring affordable art programs to the southern Connecticut area with art opportunities and resources to artists, students, and community members. Our main purpose is to create a creative sanctuary with classes, workshops, events, and opportunities for community members to help connect them to the art world.

The art collective is home base for individual artists, who will use the space to further their art and create learning opportunities for both youth and adults. In addition to the artist studio spaces. Our current artist residing at SoMA are Linalynn Schmelzer with River Valley Dance Project, Erin Gordon with Wellness Room Deep River, and Jeni Grey-Roberts with RiverFire Glass. Shell & Bee Studio will run full art programs out of 3 classrooms, and we have a studio store that celebrates local makers and artists, and gallery event space.

We host an art opening the 3rd Friday of every month that showcases one local artist or a small group of artists. We also host quarterly Sunday art markets. Check out our events for more details
