CONNECTICUT RIVER PUMPOUT BOAT OPERATOR

The managers of the Connecticut River Pumpout Boat Program are seeking a part-time weekday, weekend, and relief pumpout boat operator for the 2024 boating season.

Weekdays and weekends from Memorial Day until the last weekend in October.

Hours of service are from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. weather permitting.

Boats are based in Essex.

The area of coverage is East Haddam Bridge to, but not including, Long Island Sound.

Pay is \$16 - \$18 per hour, depending on experience.

Candidate Requirements Include:

- Valid Boating Safety Certificate (or commitment to take the course) and small boat handling experience. Knowledge of the lower Connecticut River is a plus .
- The ability to apply common sense and to carry out instructions that are furnished in written, oral or diagrammatic form.
- Ability to lift and/or carry objects of 25 to 50 pounds.
- Ability to work in extreme weather conditions, including heat or cold, with temperatures sufficiently high or low enough to cause marked bodily discomfort.
