



STATE ELECTION  
NOVEMBER 8, 2022

The State Election, legally warned, was held on November 8, 2022 at the Community Room at the Deep River Public Library from 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. Craig Rogoff served as Head Moderator. A total of 204 Absentee Ballots, including two 45-Day ballots were delivered to the poll by the Town Clerk. A total of 2292 votes were cast. Registered voters on the November 8, 2022, list totaled 3,399 plus 32 voters who were registered through Election Day Registration. Voter turnout was 67%. The voters on the Official Check List at the opening of polls were registered as follows:
