A Primary of the enrolled members of the Democratic Party of the Town of Deep River, legally warned by the Connecticut Secretary of the State, was held on August 11, 2020, in the Deep River Elementary School Gymnasium from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the date and location were changed to allow for clean, safe, socially distanced voting. By Executive Order of Governor Lamont, Covid-19 concerns became a valid reason for voting by absentee ballot causing a large shift away from voting at the polls. The following candidates received the number of votes shown respectively, for nomination for President of the United States.

Joe Biden	402
Bernie Sanders	68
Tulsi Gabbard	9
Uncommitted	7

The total number of eligible Democratic voters was 1127. A total of 486 votes were cast: 133 in person and 353 by absentee ballot. Voter turnout was 43%. Head Moderator was Craig Rogoff. The winner statewide was Joe Biden.

The total number of eligible Republican voters was 659. A total of 126 votes were cast: 78 in person and 48 by absentee ballot. Voter turnout was 19%. Head Moderator was Craig Rogoff. The winner statewide was Donald J. Trump. An automatic close vote recount was triggered for the 2nd Congressional District seat and was held on August 15, 2020. The count remained unchanged.
