

REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT #4 BUDGET REFERENDUM May 3, 2022

A budget referendum of electors and citizens qualified to vote at Town Meetings in the Town of Deep River was held in the Community Meeting Room at the Deep River Public Library, 150 Main Street, Deep River, on Tuesday, May 3, 2022, between the hours of 12 noon and 8 p.m. for the approval of the Regional School District #4 Budget in the amount of twenty one million, six hundred eighty five thousand, two hundred thirty nine dollars (\$21,685,239) for the fiscal year July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023. Poll voting was done by ballot tabulator while absentee ballots were counted by hand. A total of 110 votes were counted including 0 non-registered property owners and 8 absentee ballots. The total number of registered voters on the current list was 3,313. Voter turnout was 3%. Lucy Salicrup served as moderator.
